

### Leviticus 25:8-10a NLT

"In addition, you must count off seven Sabbath years, seven sets of seven years, adding up to forty-nine years in all. <sup>9</sup> Then on the Day of Atonement in the fiftieth year, blow the ram's horn loud and long throughout the land. <sup>10</sup> Set this year apart as holy, a time to proclaim freedom throughout the land for all who live there. It will be a jubilee year for you...

### Leviticus 26:33-35 NLT

"I will scatter you among the nations and bring out my sword against you. Your land will become desolate, and your cities will lie in ruins. 34 Then at last the land will enjoy its neglected Sabbath years as it lies desolate while you are in exile in the land of your enemies. Then the land will finally rest and enjoy the Sabbaths it missed. 35 As long as the land lies in ruins, it will enjoy the rest you never allowed it to take every seventh year while you lived in it."

### Jeremiah's Lesson for Exiles

- 70 years of captivity in Babylon...
- As judgement on Israel's sin.
   The Lord will restore...
- But repentance precedes return.

### Jeremiah 29:10 NLT

This is what the Lord says: "You will be in Babylon for seventy years. But then I will come and do for you all the good things I have promised, and I will bring you home again.

#### 2 Chronicles 36:21 NLT

So the message of the LORD spoken through Jeremiah was fulfilled. **The land finally enjoyed its Sabbath rest**, lying desolate until the seventy years were fulfilled, just as the prophet had said.

### Daniel 9:2; 20-21 NIV | Return & Restoration for Israel

...in the first year of his (Darius) reign, I, Daniel, understood from the Scriptures, according to the word of the LORD given to Jeremiah the prophet, that the desolation of Jerusalem would last **seventy years**...

While I was speaking and praying, confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel and making my request to the LORD my God for his holy hill —  $^{21}$  while I was still in prayer, Gabriel, the man I had seen in the earlier vision, came to me in swift flight about the time of the evening sacrifice.

### **Daniel 9:22-24a** NIV

- To anoint Most Holy Place

### A Prophetic Timeline

### Daniel 9:25 NIV

"Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One, the ruler, comes, there will be seven 'sevens,' and sixty-two 'sevens.' It will be rebuilt with streets and a trench, but in times of trouble."


### Daniel 9:25

### Luke 4:16-20 NIV | Jesus Commences The Ultimate Jubilee

He (Jesus) went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, 17 and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written: 18 "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, <sup>19</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." <sup>20</sup> Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him.



A dying Messiah A destructive Ruler

### **Daniel 9:26-27** NIV

After the sixty-two 'sevens,' the Anointed One will be put to death and will have nothing. The people of the ruler who will come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end will come like a flood: War will continue until the end, and desolations have been decreed. 27 He will confirm a covenant with many for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that causes desolation, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him."




