

Context:

The *emotional* state of the disciples

They'd had a long day of ministry.

They'd fed well OVER 5,000 people.

They rowed all night against heavy winds.

They missed a night of sleep.

It was still dark... probably around 4:00 am.

They felt isolated... alone.

They feared for their lives.
