

Ephesians 6:1-9

Discussion Questions

Opening Questions:

What does this passage teach us about God?

1. What do verses 1-3 teach about God's heart for families and the significance of obedience in His design?
2. How does verse 4 reflect God's character as a Father who disciplines in love without provoking anger?
3. What does the command to obey "as you would Christ" (v. 5) teach about God's priorities in how we serve others?
4. In verse 9, what does God's impartiality reveal about His justice and His view of all people?

What does this passage teach us about ourselves?

1. How does the command to honor your parents (vv. 1-3) challenge you, regardless of your age or stage of life?
2. If you're a parent (or in any position of authority), how do you see yourself in verse 4? In what ways do you build up or provoke those under your care?
3. How do verses 5-8 challenge the way you approach work, service, or submission to authority in your own life?
4. How does verse 9 challenge the way you use any power, privilege, or influence you have over others?

Deeper Questions:

1. What do verses 1-4 reveal about areas where you may struggle with honoring authority or guiding others in love?
2. How do verses 5-9 confront attitudes you might have toward work, authority, or fairness?
3. How does the promise in verse 3—"that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land"—encourage you to trust God's design?

4. How does the reminder in verse 8 that God will reward faithful service “whether slave or free” give you hope?
5. How does this passage give you reasons to praise God for His goodness and love?
6. What specific sins—disrespect, harshness, laziness, or favoritism—do you need to repent of in light of this passage?
7. How can you practice obedience or service “with a sincere heart, as you would Christ” in your daily life? (v. 5)
8. How can this passage inspire you to love and serve those in your family, workplace, or community in a way that reflects Christ’s love?
9. How does seeing God’s impartiality (v. 9) deepen your love for Him?
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
