

## Discussion Questions - Ephesians 1:11-23

The phrase **“for the praise of His glory”** shows up twice in the first three verses!  
*Hallelujah!*

1. Where should our focus logically shift because of this phrase? Why might that shift be profoundly difficult?
2. What, practically, are some ways the Lord is prompting you to obedience in daily life “for the praise of His glory”?
3. How does “for the praise of His glory” personally increase your confidence in His infinite Lordship over your finite understanding? (Let’s praise Him together by proclaiming it now together!)
4. *Paul clearly had deep affection for the believers he was writing to, and he emphatically prayed over them in his absence, encouraging them as he was able with letters and messengers.*

Who might specifically be on your heart to pray over and with what spiritual wealth is the Lord compelling you to pray over them?

5. How have the truths in Ephesians 1:17-23 pierced your spirit to greater faith or repentance and freedom?
